Late Entries: Late entries may be accepted strictly at the organizers' discretion, at a fee of £20. Late entries are strongly discouraged though, due to expected entry size.

Membership cards: Fencers must be members of British Fencing or Home Countries. Membership cards must be shown at check in. (Membership available on the day if permitted by British Fencing)

Referees: Clubs submitting three or more fencers must provide a referee for each group of three.

Refreshments: Light refreshments will be available.

Equipment: Full kit must be worn. (No tracksuit bottoms).

All clothing & equipment must conform to British Fencing regulations (January 2007).

Under 9's must use size 0 blades. Under 11's and under 13's must use size 3 blades or less.

Under 15's must use size 5 blades or less.

Armourer: An armourer will be available for repairs.

This is the “**Leon Paul Junior Series ID**”. If you want to have your results included in the Leon Paul rankings then you ***MUST*** include this ID.

Your unique identification code for the LPJS will consist of two initials (first name followed by surname), then your date of birth in the format ddmmyy and then your sex, either M or F. Please note you should ignore all middle names and if your surname is double barreled just use the first letter. For example, Louise Bond-Williams use letters LB. I am Alex Paul, my date of birth is 17th of June 1978 and I am male therefore my unique code is AP170678M. You should use your code in all correspondence regarding the LPJS.
